The 2008 Cabernet Sauvignon exhibits lots of cassis and blueberry fruit as well as hints of charcoal, licorice, and crushed rocks.

An outstanding value in Napa Cabernet, the 2008 Cabernet Sauvignon's opaque ruby/purple hue is followed by copious notes of crushed rock, blueberry pie, pen ink and black fruits. Full-bodied, opulent and fleshy with impressive purity and a long finish, this terrific Cabernet can be drunk now or cellared for 15+ years.
